YOUR LIBRARY CARD

The Buchanan District Library (BDL) is supported by local funding. Residents of the library district and any extended service areas may receive a card free of charge. Children may receive cards if their parents/guardians are card holders. You must have your library card with you in order to check out items. Replacement cards are available for \$2.00. If your card is lost or stolen, please let us know immediately.

DUE DATES, FINES, RENEWALS

BOOKS, AUDIOBOOKS, & MUSIC CDS

Loan Period: 3 Weeks, one renewal. Music CDs limited to 5 per account.

MAGAZINES Loan Period: I week, one renewal.

DVDS, BLU-RAYS, AND VIDEO GAMES

Loan Period: I week, no renewals. Limit 5 DVD/Blu-rays, 3 video games per account.

VOX AND WONDERBOOKS

Loan Period: 3 weeks, one renewal. Limit 3 per account, (18+ only). Must be returned inside the library, NOT in the Drop Box.

LIBRARY OF THINGS

Loan Period: I week, one renewal. For high demand Things, loan period is 3 days, no renewals. Limit 2 Things per linked household (18+ only). Must be returned inside the library, NOT in the Drop Box.

FINES AND CHARGES

BDL believes in free and equal access for all. For this reason, we choose not to charge late fines. In return, we ask everyone do their part to be responsible library users. If items are overdue for an extended period of time or are damaged, replacement costs may be charged. When billed for lost or damaged items, all borrowing privileges are suspended for the patron and linked household accounts. The suspension remains in effect until items are returned or charges are paid below \$5.00. Charges over \$25.00 will be referred to a collection agency and will incur a \$10.00 collections fee.

YOUR ACCOUNT

Access your account online by visiting www.buchananlibrary.org and clicking "Search our Catalog," then "Log into Your Account" on the catalog page with your library card and phone number. View your account, place a hold, renew an item, write a review, suggest an item for purchase, or choose to automatically receive new books through Reserve Express. Edit your contact information or subscribe to the library's newsletter. Also access the library's electronic resources. Alternatively, download the myLIBRO app and log in with your library card and phone number.

RENEWING ITEMS

Most BDL materials can be renewed by calling the library at 269-695-3681, logging into your library account from the library website or the *myLIBRO* app, or in person at the library. Items on hold for another patron cannot be renewed.

COMPUTER USAGE

Wi-Fi and public computer terminals are available free of charge. Printing is available; ask staff for prices.

HOME BOUND SERVICE

Available for those with a valid library card who are unable to visit the library due to handicap or illness. Call Erin Ross for details at 269-695-3681.

CURBSIDE SERVICE

Can't make it into the library? We'll bring items out to you in the parking lot. Call the library for more information.

LOCAL HISTORY ROOM

The Buchanan area's rich and diverse history is preserved in this collection. Research requests may be made at the Front Desk, by telephone, or by emailing *localhistory@buchananlibrary.org. The Berrien County Record* and other local newspapers dating back from 1869 to the present, as well as Berrien County censuses from 1830-1910 and Michigan Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps are available for viewing on microfilm. *The Berrien County Record* from June 1869-June 1939 is also available for searching on the library computers and the library's website. The Local History Room is open to the public when the archivist is available; call or email for hours or to schedule an appointment.

ELECTRONIC RESOURCES

MYLIBRO

Download the library's app to search and browse the catalog, access your library account to view, renew, and reserve items, and more! Go to your app store and download the myLIBRO app, search for Buchanan District Library and log in with your library card and phone number (PIN).

LIBBY

Libby offers free eBooks and digital audiobooks. Download the *Libby* app on your device and log in with your library card and phone number (PIN). Borrow up to 7 items at a time. Go to the "How do 1... Download free eBooks & audiobooks?" tab on the library website for more information.

HOOPLA

Hoopla offers free eBooks and digital audiobooks, music, and videos. Download the *hoopla* app on your device and log in with your library card and phone number (PIN) and an email address. Borrow 5 items a month. Go to the "How do I... Download free eBooks & audiobooks?" tab on the library website for more information.

MELCAT AND MEL.ORG

The Michigan eLibrary (MeL) gives you access to databases where you can read full text articles from magazines and newspapers, view auto repair manuals, explore cultural and genealogical resources, take practice tests for college and professional exams like the ACT or GED, and much more! You also can request items from libraries across the state, including university libraries, using MeLCat, Michigan's interlibrary loan service. Go to *www.mel.org* to get started. Use the search box to search MeLCat by keyword. To explore MeL's databases, click the "eResources" or "Kids" tabs at the top of the MeL webpage.
