

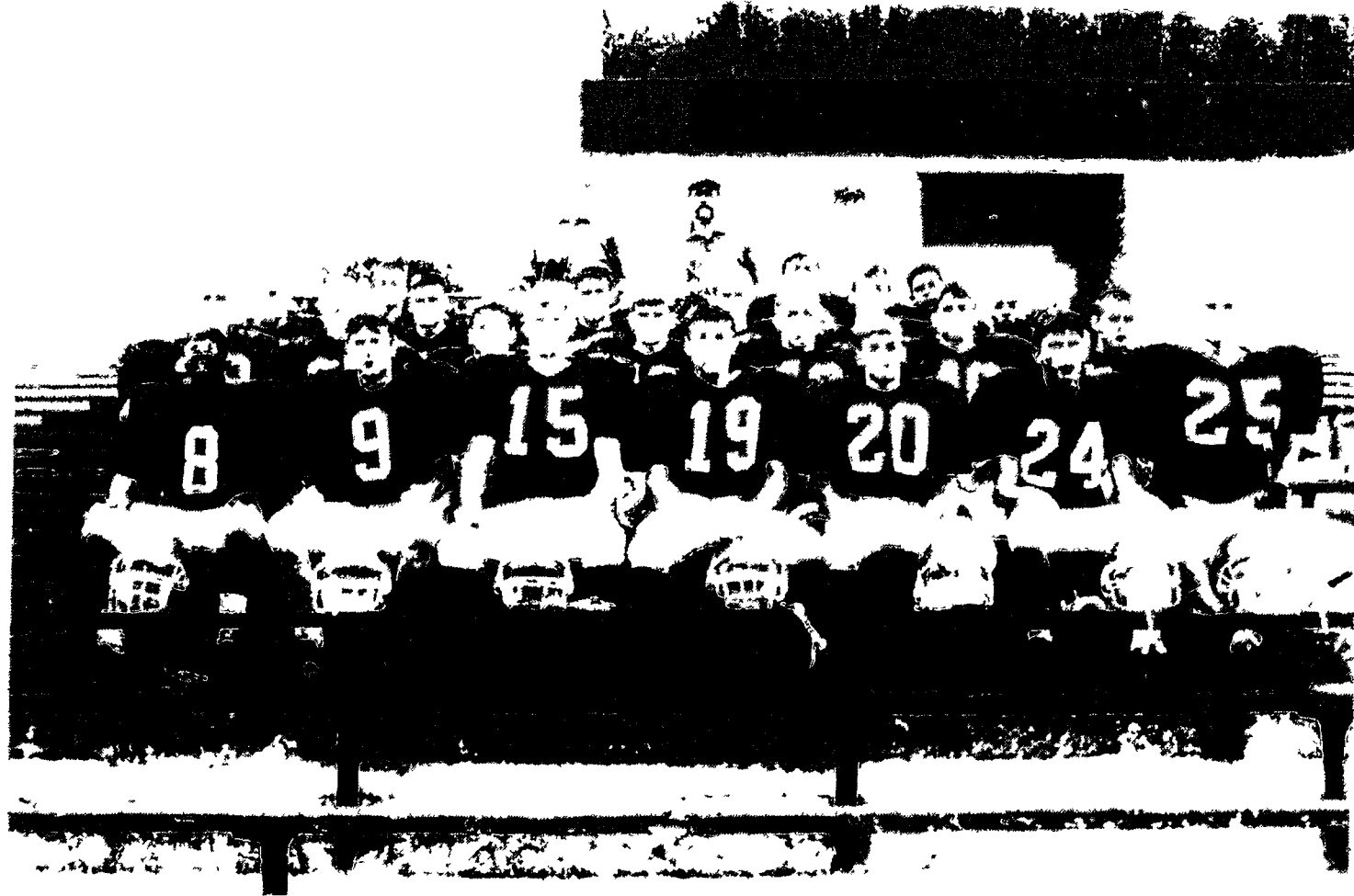

Buchanan Varsity Football Team

Buchanan to employ two-platoon system

BUCHANAN — Frank Mucha, in his ninth year as head coach of the Buchanan football team, has installed the two-platoon system this season in hopes of overcoming the inexperience of his young team.

The other reason for his implementing the system is to keep the kids fresh and to get more of them involved in each game.

Buchanan completed its eighth winning season in the last nine years in 1993. But Mucha knows his team will have to mature in a hurry to keep that impressive streak going.

Seven seniors return on defense this year for Buchanan: Steve Passing (5-10, 155) and Matt Payne (5-10, 162) will be playing safety, Tom Rager (5-11, 188) and Tom Desenberg (5-9, 153) will be at defensive ends, Phil Neely (5-11, 193) and Andrew Schutze (6-0, 150) will be the tackle position. Nate Barz (5-9, 178) will return at the nose position.

The rest of the defense will be Cade Baumgart (5-8, 145) at defensive back, Kirk Carson (6-7, 212) at tackle, Wayne Kolberg (5-10, 190) at tackle, and Jarrod Ferris (6-0, 171) at linebacker.

Only three seniors return for the Bucks on offense. They are Bill Linn (5-8, 130) at wideout, Robert Hickok (5-8, 130) at running back and Keith Welsh (5-8, 160) at quarterback. Junior Pat Hanlin (6-0, 190) will also see time at quarterback.

Ryan Harris, a sophomore, will be at wideout and Nathan Whitfield and George Widman will start at the two tight end positions. Jason Danek will also be in the backfield.

Mucha will be starting from scratch with his front line. He is counting on Chad Thompson (6-0, 233) at center, Tim Morris (6-1, 174) and Landon Clark (5-10, 168) at the guards and Ryan Johnson (5-11, 241) and Jarrett Burgess (6-1, 297) at the tackles.

Bridgman is off to a slow start, as they are 0-4 for the young season.



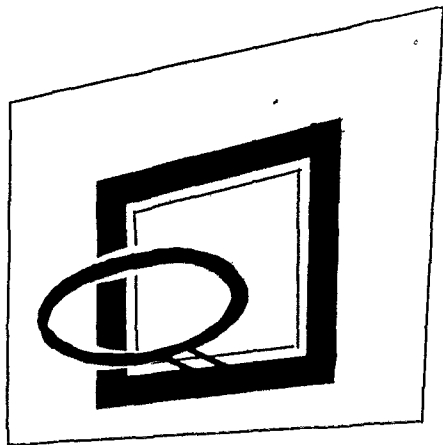
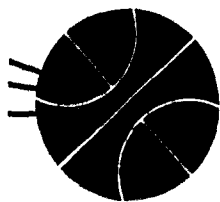

CARDS AND COLLECTING



One of basketball collecting's historic early sets is the 1957 Topps edition. The only Topps basketball set produced before 1969, it contains the first or oldest cards of many of the all-time greats .. Card #3 is the first card of NEIL JOHNSTON, an early scoring champion. The 6-foot-8 hook-shot specialist joined the Philadelphia Warriors in 1951. Neil led the league in scoring three straight seasons, 1952-55, and rebounding in 1954-55 .. His Warriors team won the 1956 NBA championship .. The '57 Topps set has 80 cards and is worth more than \$5,000 in near-mint condition, with Johnston's card priced at about \$50 ..

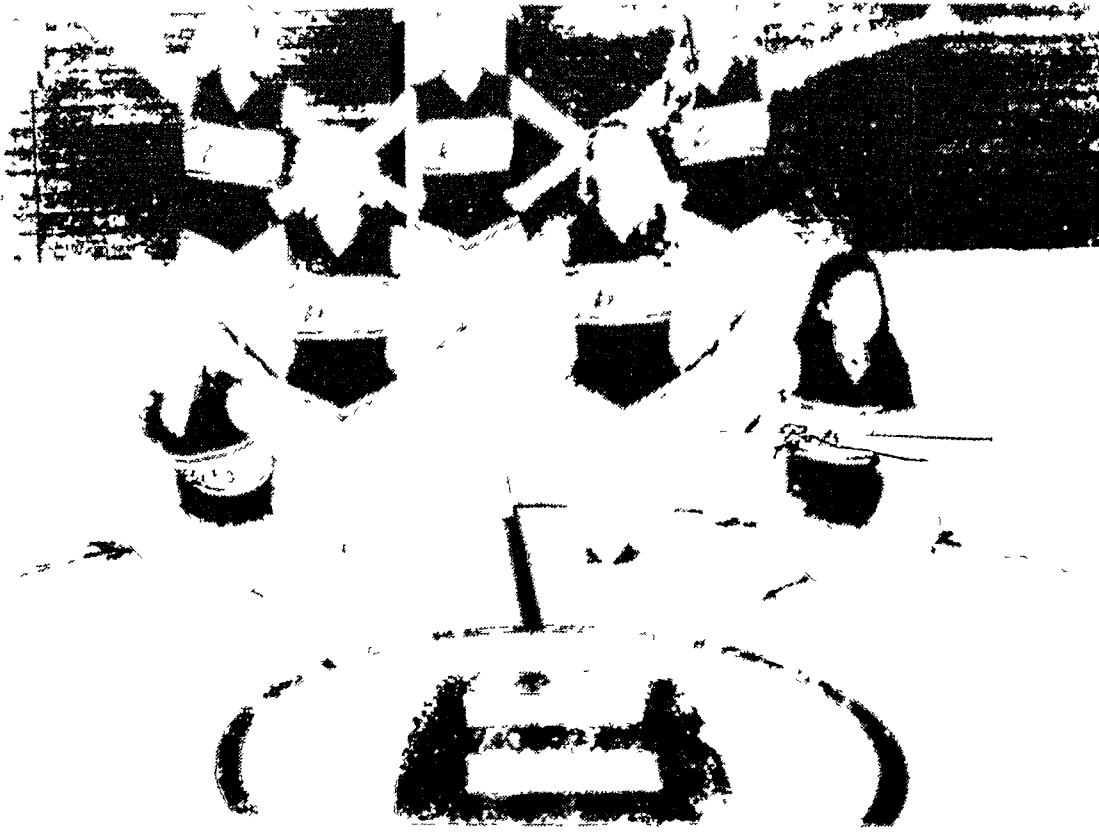

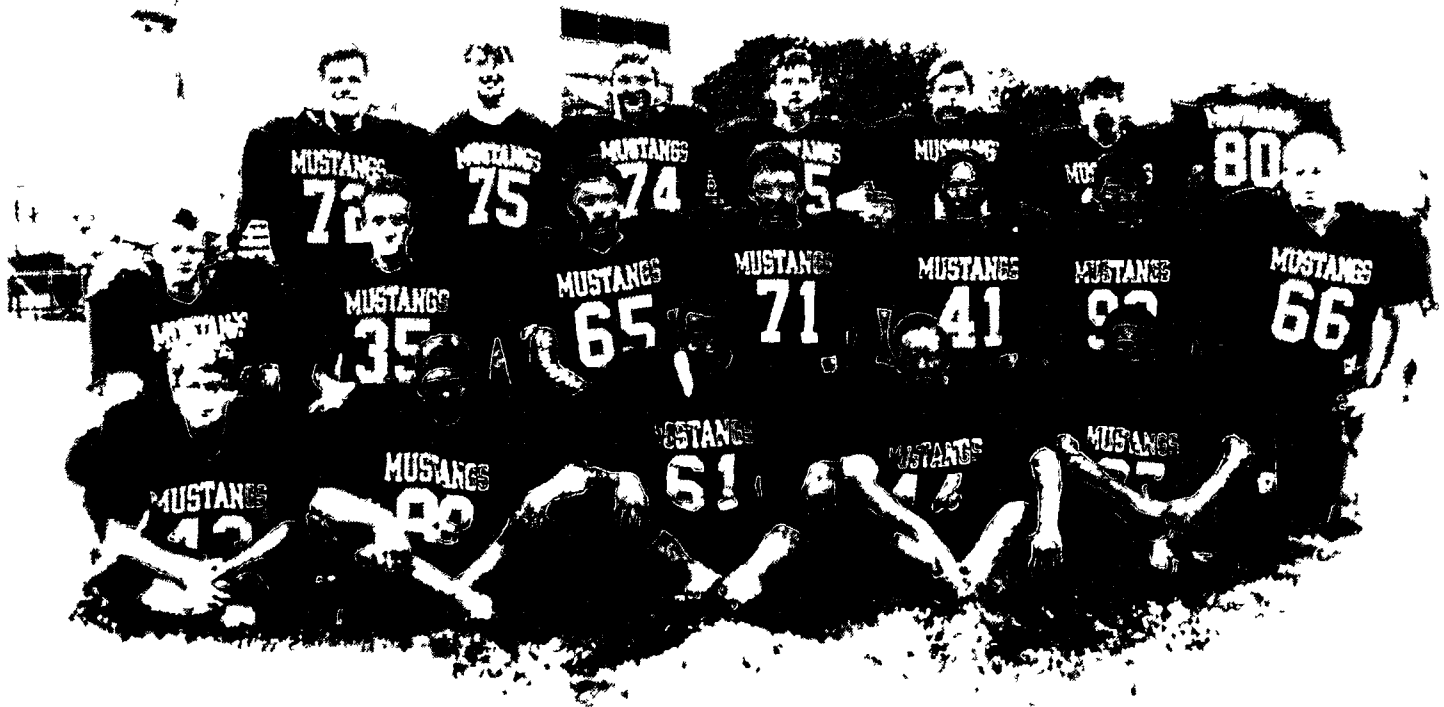

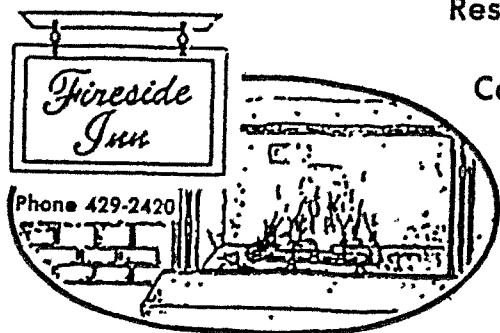
CARDS AND COLLECTING



Many current football fans do not remember teams known as the Brooklyn Dodgers or the Boston Yanks of the NFL, or the New York Yankees of the All-America Football Conference, but all were quarterbacked by CLARENCE PARKER, known as "Ace" .. Parker was an All-American at Duke in 1936, and won the 1940 MVP trophy while with the football Dodgers. His Yankees team went to the first AAFC title game, in '46, but lost to the Cleveland Browns. Ace also played baseball for the Philadelphia A's, but his Hall of Fame career was definitely on the gridiron. He is shown here on a card from the Swell Football Greats set of 1988.

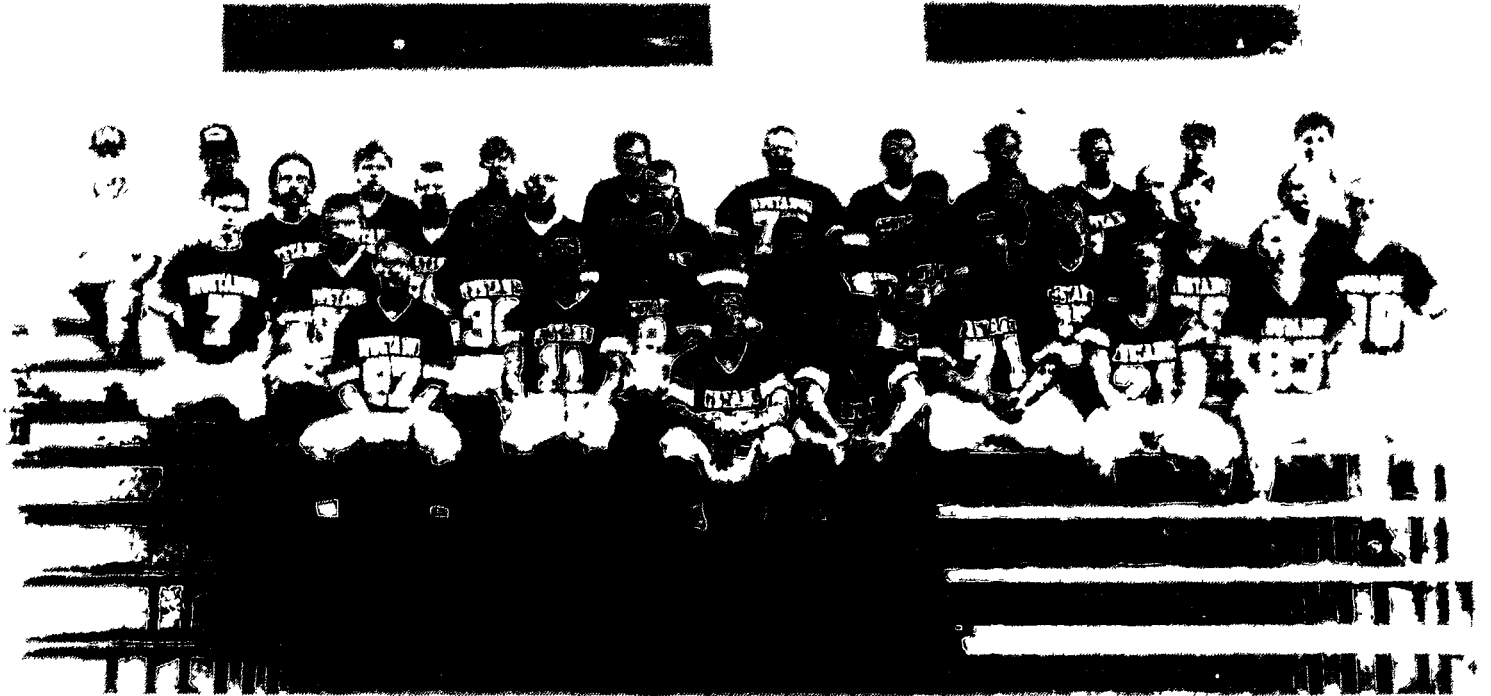
220) and Drew Wahl (6-1, 210) at tackle, and John Spiekhout (6 0, 175) and Archie Beckman (6-0, 160) at guard.

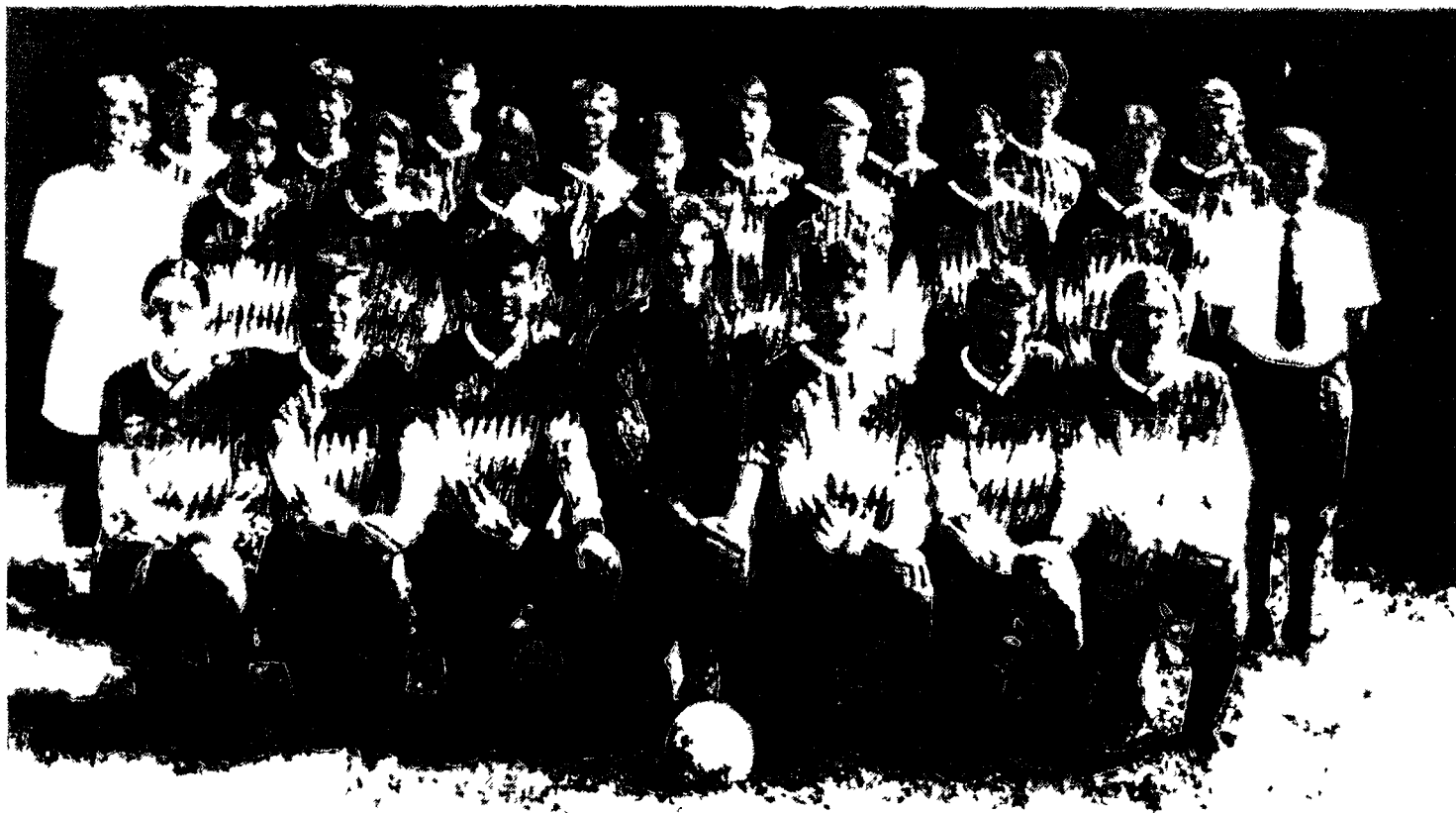
The Bees are hoping to challenge for the Class "C-D" districts, which will be hosted at Bridgman this year.
