Buchanan graduates look forward to the future

BUCHANAN — The weather was beautiful, although some may say a bit warm, as Buchanan Community Schools graduated its 117th class on June 19.

Three representatives of the senior class gave commencement addresses.

Tessa Greathouse described her memories of the last four years in high school and told her classmates not to forget theirs. She told the graduates that this might be the last time they see each other again, so leave one special memory.

"Everyone deserves one last special memory to be remembered by," she said.

She also described how hard it is for her to make a future for herself while leaving some friends and classmates behind.

"It is so hard to move on knowing that you won't be by my side anymore. You'll be behind me," said Greathouse.

Co-valedictorian Erin McKean took a different approach for her commencement address. She implored her classmates to make a difference in their world, dedicate their lives to others and be role models. She explained that while

making a difference doesn't always earn recognition, it does bring tremendous satisfaction.

"It doesn't matter how insignificant something you're doing may seem," said McKean.

C.J. Remmo focused on friendships. He read a poem that expressed how important friends are and closed his speech by giving thanks to the Class of 1994.

"You are truly my golden friends and forever will remain so," said Remmo.

Also during the ceremony, William McBeth, high school principal, thanked the graduates for tolerating the school's renovation project, which lasted well into October and forced them to attend split sessions at the middle school.

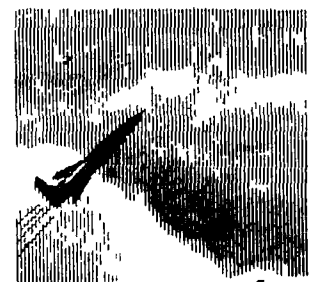

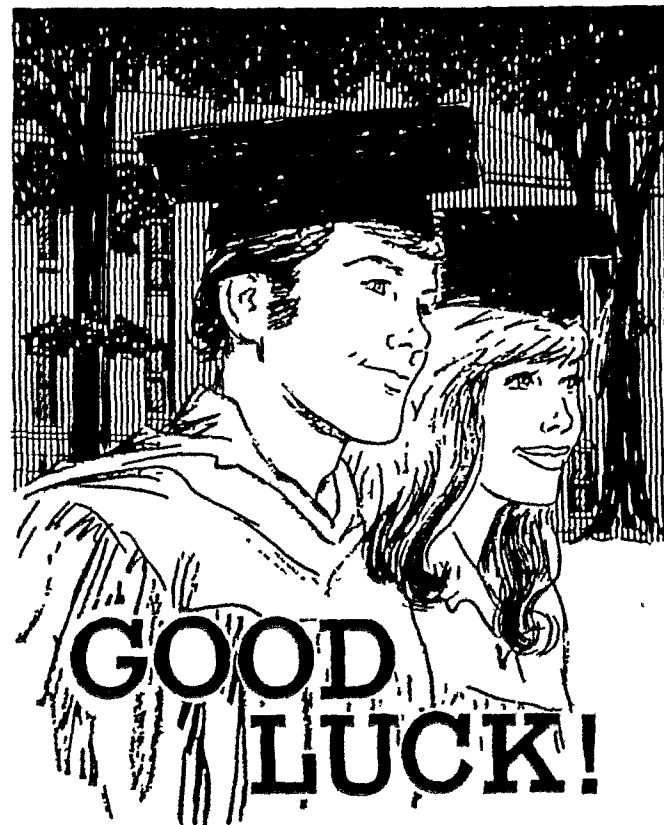

Rachel's future plans include attending St. Joseph's College, where she has earned a trustee's scholarship to major in business management and political science.

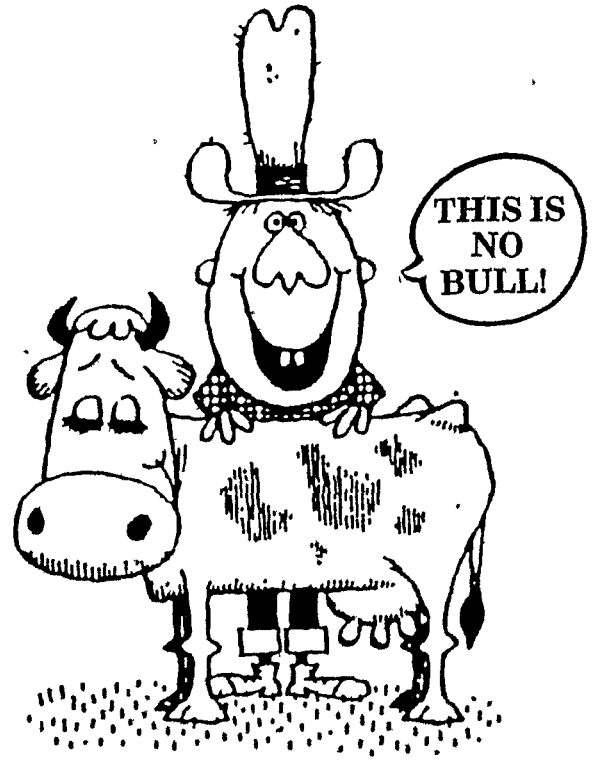
Galien's graduation will be held on May 26, 8 p.m. in the school's gymnasium.

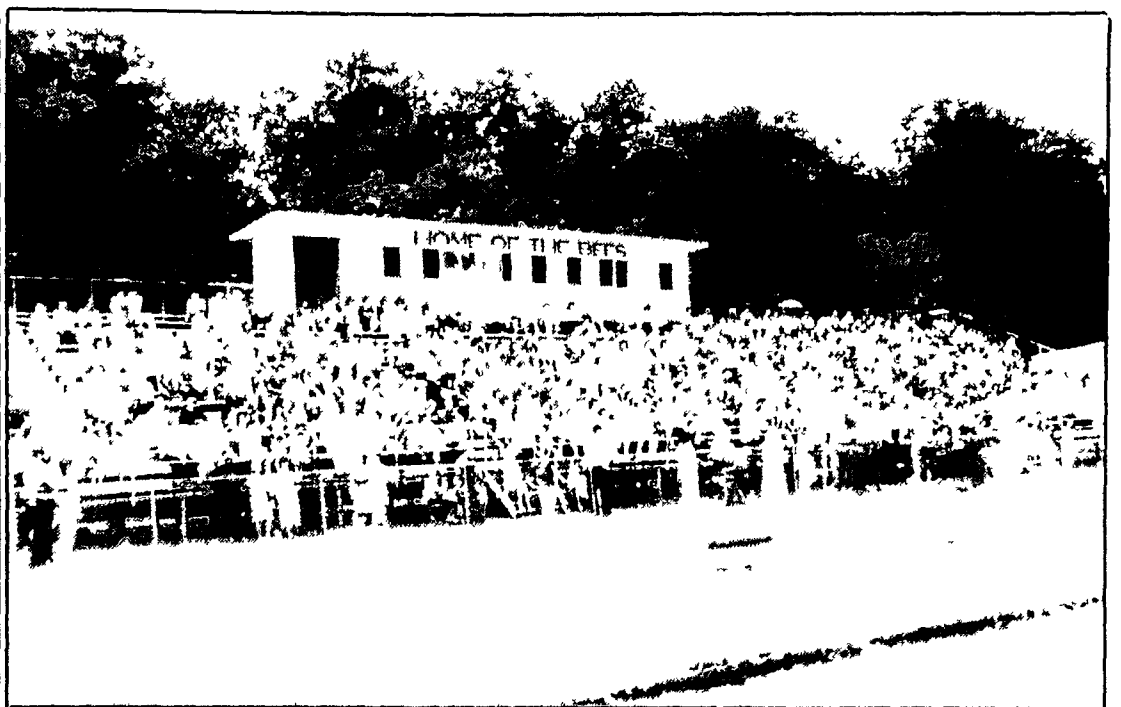

Her future plans include attending Kalamazoo College.

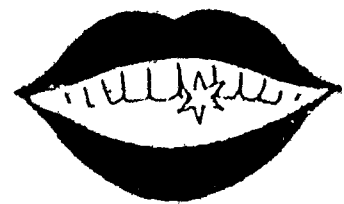
