Society, pep band, French Club Drama Club, and cross country track. He is also president of student government. Next year, he plans to attend Michigan State University.

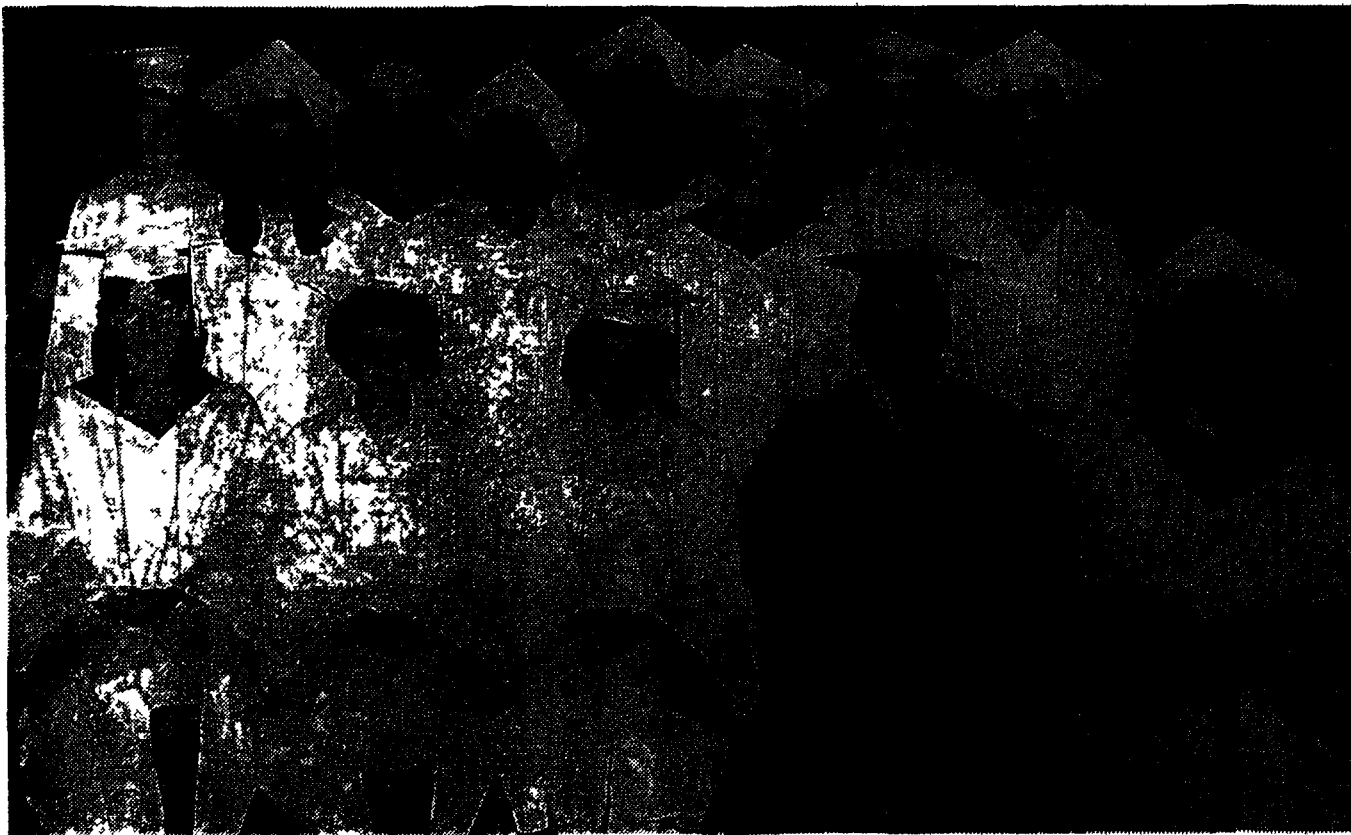

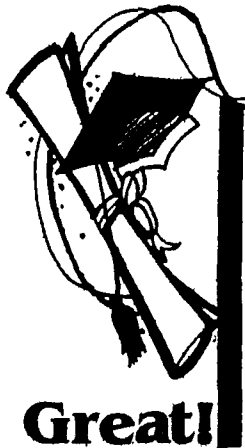
