Coach Dinegan tells it like it is

BUCHANAN — Buchanan coach, John Dinegan, is looking for a big season from his three-year starter 6-4 senior Seth Brown and sophomore 6-7 Kirk Carson. The hope is that this year the Bucks have a shot at the Lakeland Conference title.

The Bucks will put an experienced back court on the floor with Brown and Carson, who was brought up to the varsity team late last season after his brother, Bill Carson, was out with an injury. Joining this duo at the other forward position will be 6-2 Brian Paturalski, another returning letterman from last-year's team.

Brown brings his strong moves to the basket which netted him a 20.1 points-per-game average last year. Dinegan hopes that Carson's size will give the Bucks strength on the boards and will take some of the pressure off Brown.

The big question for Buchanan will be the guard position. Starting at guard will be 5-9 Brandon Brown and 5-9 Jason Danek, who both saw limited playing time last year. Dinegan sees Brown as the ball handler and Danek as the top outside shooter.

Buchanan's team will have to get it together quickly though, as they face defending league champion Coloma in their second game of the season and this year's favorite for the title, Lakeshore in the seventh game of the season.

Miller building Bees for winning season

The Bridgman varsity boys basketball squad is busy preparing for the 1994-95 season, and the Bees hope to build a winning season. Bridgman will return seven varsity letter winners from last season. The Bees won three of their last four regular season games and finished third in the Red Arrow Conference with an 8-6 league record. Bridgman will also receive help from a 19-1 junior varsity squad from last year.

Coach Mike Miller returns for his third season with the Bees. Miller has an 83-46 career coaching record with a 21-22 record at Bridgman. According to Coach Miller, "We are a much improved team compared to last season and believe that we can be a darkhorse in the conference race." Bridgman returns five seniors in forward Chris Mendus with 41 points and 68 rebounds, Tim Tate with 78 points, 5.7 rebounds, 15 steals and 35 assists, center David Helfman with 21 points and 36 rebounds; forward Eric Rochefort with 10 points, and Greg Schroeder with 12 points. Juniors Jerimee Gauthier and Don Riggins are



Sanford has high praise for Lancers

Coach Jim Sanford's Lancers are coming off an 18-3 record with nine lettermen, three of whom were starters. Now that should give the Lakeshore coaches and fans some high expectations.

Sanford said, "Not since I began coaching here at Lakeshore 18 years ago, have I started with a more experienced group." He also commented that this group is a very hard-working bunch with great work ethics and play very well together.

Lakeshore's returning lettermen includes 6-3 forward Erik Hudak who averaged 14.8 points and connected on 27 treys last year. Sanford said, "Erik is an excellent all-around player and can do it all."

The front court boasts a pair of rugged rebounders in 6-3 Steve Wark and 6-7 Drew Hartman. After a slow start last year due to a back problem, Wark ended the season with an 8.7 average along with six rebounds per game. Drew Hartman grew another inch or two and will be tough on opponents with his shot blocking.

For the third year in a row Scott Brunke is back at point guard. With his good ballhandling and improved shooting range, he is looking to improve on his 5.6 points and 5 assists per game.

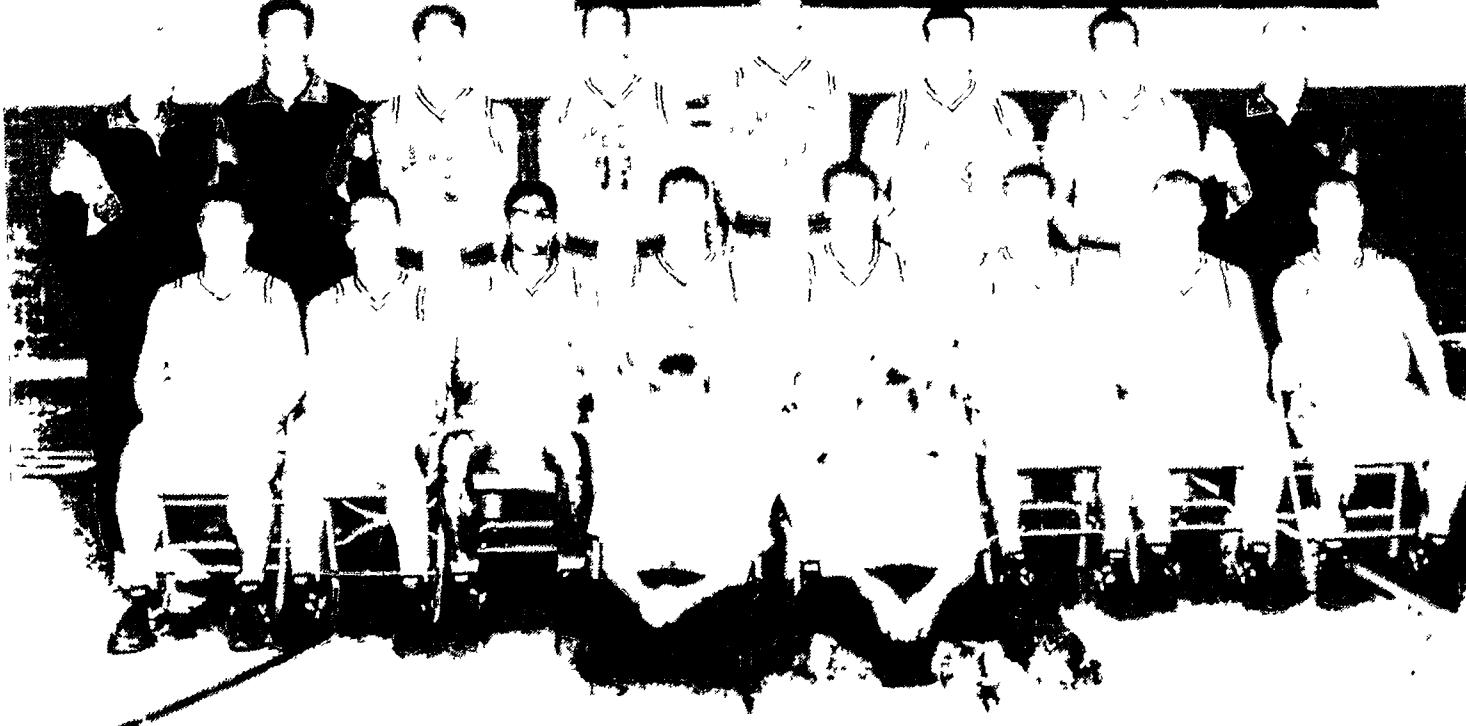

The other starter to begin this season are Wade Clark, moving up from sixth man last year when he averaged 8.2 points per game.

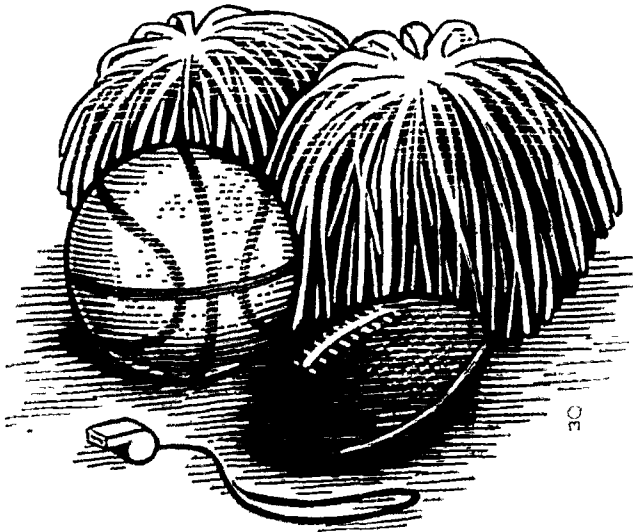
The guard positions will be backed up by able performers Drew Radtke and Josh Kerns, and Alex Wisecup and Chris Schultz will see plenty of action in the front court.

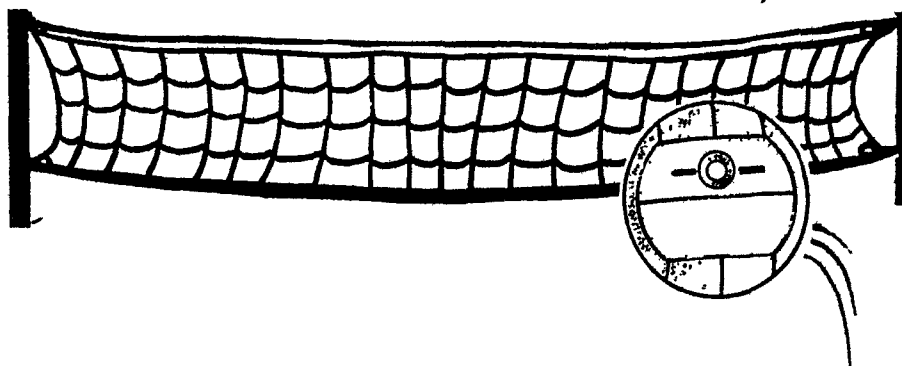

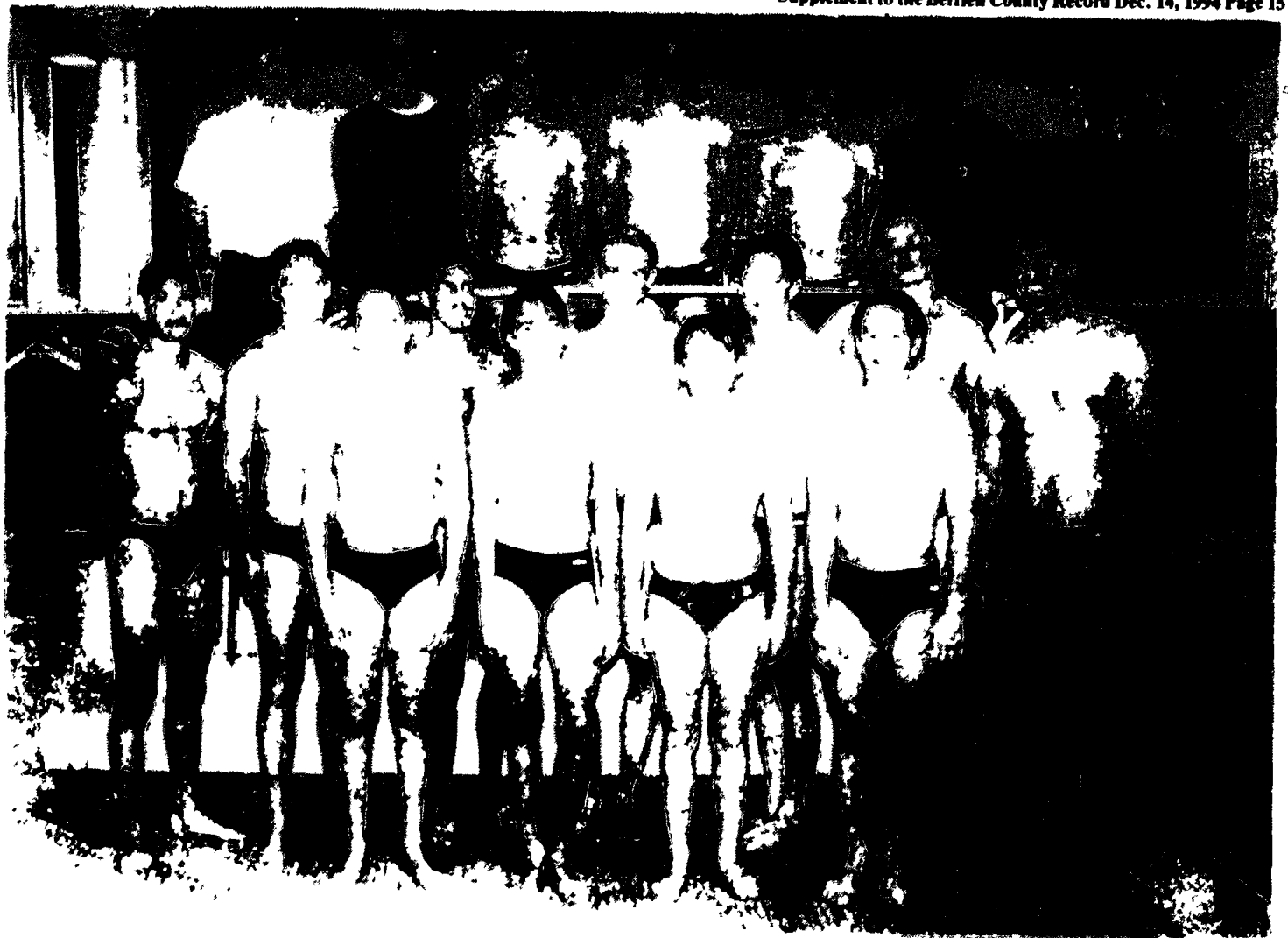

Lakeshore volleyball coach Diana Davis said, "We could not have a tougher schedule. We will challenge ourselves by playing the best teams in the state every Saturday."

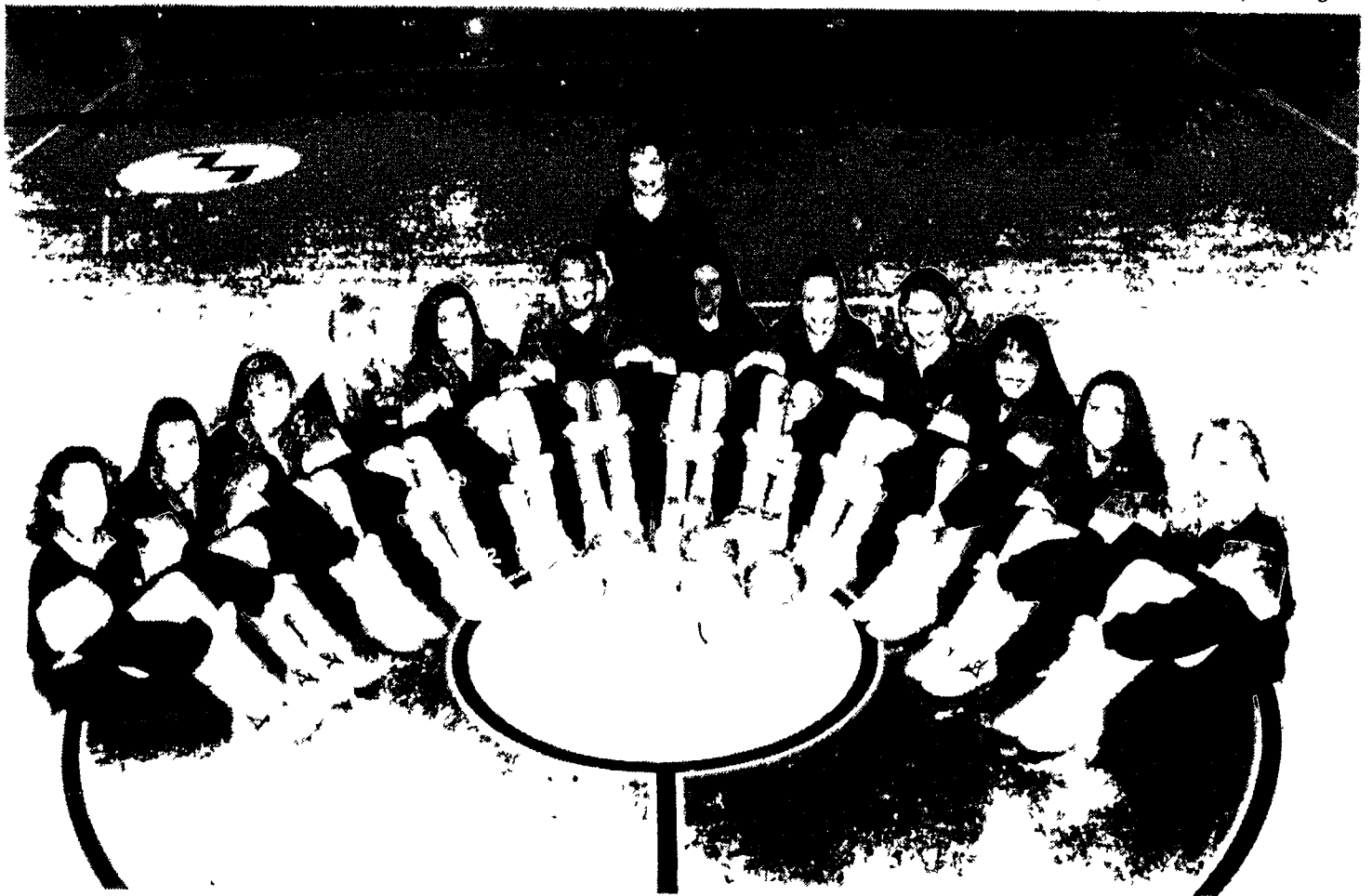
Lakeshore lost two seniors to graduation; outside hitter Veronica Duffield and all-state setter Susan Behnke.

Scherer and Herrman are both coming off undefeated Junior Varsity seasons.

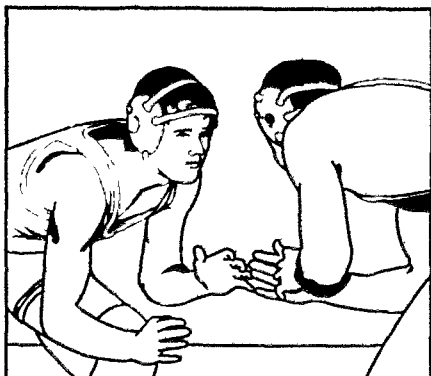

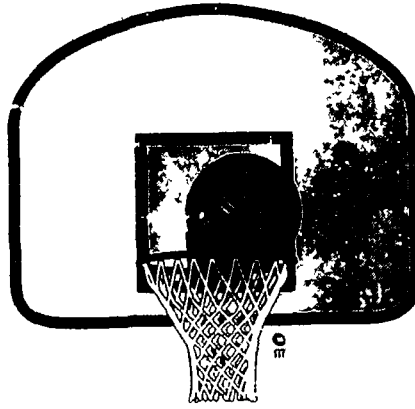
