scope and content: A collection of newspapers published in Buchanan and gathered together from a variety of sources. Weekly or semi-weekly newspapers have been published regularly in Buchanan since 1858. At times, up to three papers have competed simultaneously for the town's readership.

Buchanan's longest lived newspaper, the **Berrien County Record**, comprises the large majority of the newspapers in this collection, with nearly complete holdings for mid 1869 - early 1908, late 1927 - mid 1935, and 1939 to date. From 7 February 1884 until late 1909 this paper was known as the **Buchanan Record**. The holdings of Buchanan's earliest newspapers and of the **Record**'s numerous but relatively short-lived competitors are extremely fragmentary.

A partial index to the **Berrien County Record** and a guide to **The Connector** are available on the Local History Room's homepage.

The Buchanan District Library is engaged in a long-term project to digitize its newspaper holdings. So far, the **Berrien County Record** for 1879-1908 has been scanned and converted into PDFs. These PDFs are available for reading and searching only in the Library building. Please ask the staff for assistance.
