THE RAILROAD QUESTION—ITS LEGAL CHARACTER. Decision of the Supreme Court of Wisconsin, published in the Wisconsin State Journal, and one of the best in the country on the same question.

We give the following decision rendered by the Supreme Court of Wisconsin a few months since, touching the power of the Legislature to authorize the raising of tax for the purpose of donating it to railroads.

Supreme Court Decision. Warren Whiting appellant, vs. The Shoberg Railroad Company and others, appellants.
