THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENCY OF SCHOOLS.

Now, Mr. Editors.—Are you in earnest? I am not quite sure that Wagner & Kingery, individually, is in his right mind. Prosperity in business has warped his judgment. He is growing very economical. The "additional expense" of the County Superintendent of schools must be lopped off. This is a matter of doubt.—Eps. But it won't do. Better teachers are employed. [They, too, admit of question.—Eps.] They are attaining higher qualification. Better methods of instruction are introduced. [Not on account of the County Superintendent.—Eps.] The minds of the scholars are awakened, and their courage and ambition excited. [Is it by the Superintendent System?—Eps.] Better constructed and better furnished school-houses greet the eyes of the traveler and adorn the villages and corners of the highway. [Does the County Superintendent do this?—Eps.] A nearer approach is attained to that state of excellence and perfection in the common school system, which will be the blessings of our people, and which has been so well begun and so much encouraged by the noble liberality of the school laws [Not the County Superintendent laws, though.—Eps.] of our happy State? By the employment of better qualified teachers, several higher branches may be pursued in the common schools, thus bringing some important advantages of higher schools within reach of scholars who could not afford the expense, or could not be spared from home, to attend the Academy or Seminary in the city, thus bringing the best advantages of the free school system to the enjoyment of all the people. [If the Co. Superintendent System does this, it is indeed, most wonderful.—Eps.] Could our Legislature substitute a better and cheaper system? [We think they could.—Eps.] We shall see. Can the old system of Township Inspectors be as efficient? [About as efficient, and much cheaper.—Eps.] Will it be easier to find a competent Board of Inspectors in every town, than to find one highly qualified Superintendent for the County? [About as easy.—Eps.] Will those inspectors be likely to have the same interest and devotion to their duties, as a good Superintendent who shall overlook the entire County? [Men generally have as much interest in their own school, as an outsider.—Eps.] And will it be a cheaper method? [Certainly.—Eps.] I think I may safely say that the average cost of the County Superintendent's salary to each township does not exceed twenty-five dollars. [The salary is not all the expense of the system.—Eps.] How much less would be the fees of three School Inspectors? [Considerable; as "Basswood" will learn, if he will count it up.—Eps.] Whatever may be the result of the Superintendent in other counties, I am sure we, of Berrien County, may congratulate ourselves that the experiment has been so honorably and successfully accomplished. [A large portion of the people of Berrien County think differently.—Eps.] I hope we must lose these benefits, I hope some better reason can be given, than to save "additional expense." [Expense is only one of the many reasons.—Eps.] Economy is a prime virtue, but she must not ask us to slight the demands of Education. [We do not, but don't believe in useless expense.—Eps.] who is the hand maid of Virtue and Happiness. No doubt, we would approve of a convention for the purpose of creating an office of County Superintendent. The same niggardly spirit which refused, on our last election, to give a fair salary to our public officers, and to give money for the improvement of highways and bridges, will rejoice in the abolition of any law, however beneficial, which adds a few pennies to their taxes. [The cases are quite different.—Eps.]


