THE NEW YORK RIOT.

As we went to press Wednesday of last week, the streets of New York, the great metropolis of the new world, were teeming with thousands of excited Irish Catholics with blood in their eyes and death to Orangemen in their hearts.

The proclamation of Gov. Hoffman, setting aside the order of Supt. Kelso, came too late to prevent the shedding of blood.

The Catholic element had become so elated over its success in compelling the city officials to issue an order prohibiting the Orangemen's parade, that it would not yield to the order of the Governor.

Many, it is true, suffered terribly for their lawlessness. A hundred rioters were made to bite the dust, and perhaps three or four times as many were wounded pretty severely.

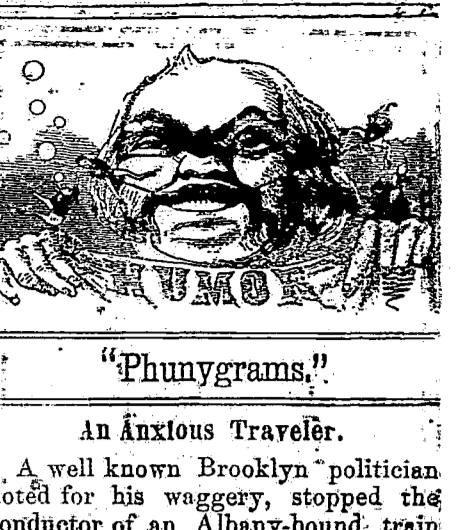
