A long interview then ensued, in which Beecher expressed to Moulton great contrition and remorse for his previous criminal dealings with Mrs. Tilton.

MY DEAR FRIEND MOULTON—I ask you to deliver this to Theodore Tilton. I humble myself before him as I do before my God. He would have been a better man in my circumstances than I have been.
