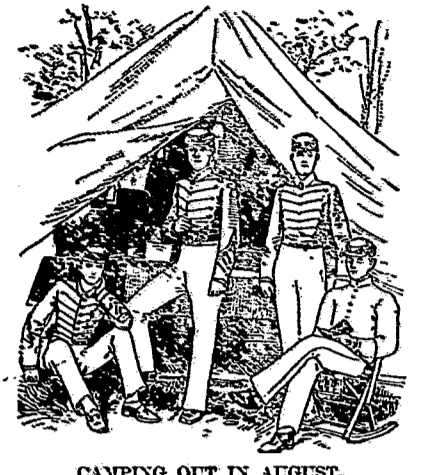


SOLDIERS IN EARNEST.

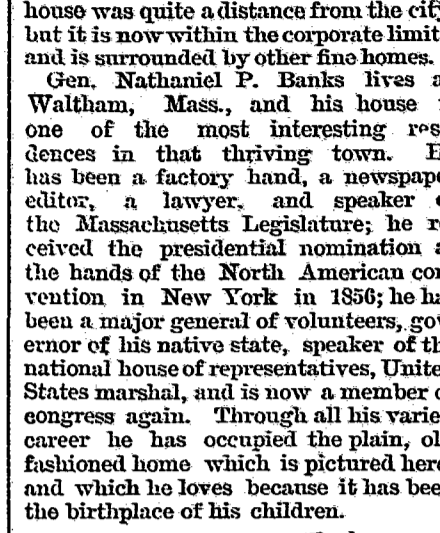
THE FAMOUS PONY EXPRESS. One of its Originators Still Alive—The Wonderful Work Done.

THE RESIDENCE OF GEN. BANKS. It is a square, two-story frame house, over one hundred years old, and was one of the first residences to be erected in Waltham.

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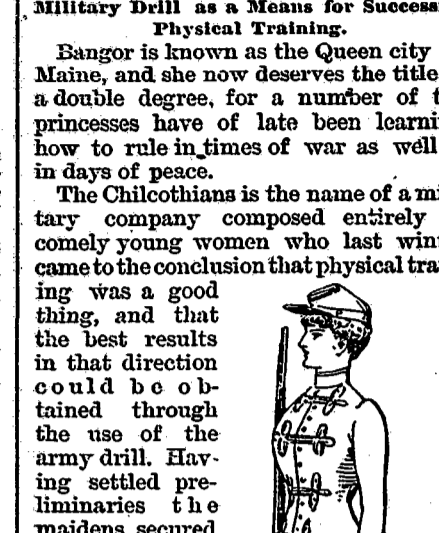
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THE RED JACKET MONUMENT.
