D. Dean Grows 86 Bu. Corn

Produces 1200 Bushels on 14 Acres, Planting Hybrid Seed

The stock of hybrid seed corn has been sent soaring in the Buchanan district by a report of the production of 1200 bushels of corn on 14 acres, 86 bushels to the acre, on the farm of Douglas Dean in the Bend of the River district.

This is the best yield reported for years in this part of Michigan. It is the contention of hybrid advocates that the use of the seed will increase production 15 bushels to the acre on well-cared-for land.
