E/5-6	Box 1-4	folders	<p>Electro-Voice manufactured sound equipment on a five-acre tract at 600 Cecil Street in Buchanan from 1946-2000. Manufacturing activities at the plant included die casting, machining, assembly, painting, and electroplating. Contamination at the site resulted from the discharge of electroplating wastes into two clay-lined lagoons from 1952-1962, and from the disposal of paint wastes and solvents into a drywell from 1964-1973. The waste disposal activities caused the ground water to become contaminated with volatile organic compounds. The plant's two seepage lagoons, drywell, and portions of the surrounding area were added to the EPA's National Priorities List on November 21, 1984.</p> <p>In conjunction with the review, planning, and implementation of remediation projects at 'Superfund' sites, the Environmental Protection Agency mandates that a local public entity maintain an information repository with reports, studies, and progress reports relating to the site and make it available to the public. The information repository at the Buchanan District Library includes initial investigations, preparations and plans for work, reports about ongoing cleanup efforts, and general-publications and resource material from the EPA. Originally conceived as a way to keep the public informed about the project and to provide the public with the information needed to provide informed input into the process, the Information Repository now acts as a documentary record of the course of the project from inception to completion.</p>
